In the natural sciences, the poster presentation is a standard mode. We will borrow this mode for the next assignment. Each student will present some of the research conducted so far, in a manner that is clear and accessible. You will create an actual thing that exists in space and time. Use one piece of white cardstock, 22 by 28 inches.

Feel free to have fun with this assignment. Use any of the following elements: text, maps, drawings, pictures from magazines, clip art, symbols, emoticons, graphs, charts, word clouds. The student will present his or her poster during a five-minute session by explaining its design and answering questions from fellow students. Plan to speak for about two minutes. Obviously, the poster presentation draws on a different set of skills: visual thinking and public speaking.

The other half of the assignment is the poster evaluation. All students must attend class on the two days when not presenting and record impressions of the posters presented on those days. The instructor will collect these impressions at the end of each class. This assignment is worth ten points: five points for the poster and presentation, five points for the recorded impressions.



Students absent on any day or days must make other arrangements or lose five points or ten points. For more guidance, visit during office hours or set an appointment.
